

HELP WRITING A LIMERICK POEM

To write a limerick, come up with a 5-line poem where the first, second, and for instance, that "help" is one of the words likely to rhyme with the spelling "-elp".

Therefore when selecting the last word in your first sentence make sure you choose something simple, which is likely to have many words that rhyme with it. Let me give you an example: There was a young fellow named Hall Who fell in the spring in the fall. He didn't write the first limerick - the first limericks came about in the early s and are often preserved in folk songs - but he popularized the form. For instance, Ron Rubin, expert versifier and jazz musician , wrote this one: There was an old drunkard of Devon, Who died and ascended to Heaven; But he cried: 'This is Hades- There are no naughty ladies, And the pubs are all shut by eleven.
